When dropping mark:

Set start line <u>at least 150 meters long</u> and perpendicular to windward mark. Provide race course information via VHF, Channel 69.

Example:

"Fifty Point Racers, Race tonight is 6-2-6-2. Start sequence will begin at 6:30. Repeat, Race is 6-2-6-2. Start sequence will begin at 6:30."

StartBot will <u>automatically</u> start the race. Horns will be sounded at the following intervals.

If StartBot is unavailable, Sound horn at 5 min, 4 min, 1 min and at start.

Time	Event	Sound
6:29 pm	1 minute Alert	3 horns (short)
6:30 pm	5 minute Warning Fleet flag UP	1 horn (short)
6:31 pm	4 minute Warning Prep Flag UP	1 horn (short)
6:34 pm	1 minute Warning Prep Flag DOWN	1 horn (short)
6:35 pm	START Fleet flag DOWN	1 horn (long)

When picking up mark:

Wait for last boat to finish race.

Pick up mark and store on your boat until next week start.

When you can not make a race or the scheduled does not work for you:

You must find another boat to take your responsibility. Trade or barter your turn and update the club executive with the change.

If a race is cancelled, the order above remains in place (ie, do NOT skip a week).
